








# PolicyStat Editor Quick Reference

<i>Required Properties to Save a Draft</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Title</li> <li>Owner*</li> <li>Policy Area*</li> <li>Approval Workflow</li> <li><b>Review Date:</b> Set by default by Policy Area. modify if needed</li> </ul>	<a href="#"><u>What information is on the Properties Menu of a policy?</u></a>
<i>Additional Properties</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Restricted Visibility:</b> Remove from public view, only accessible to users with View Restricted permissions.</li> <li><b>Policy is a Form:</b> Removes COPY watermark from printable PDF</li> <li><b>Reference Tag:</b> Additional categorization options used for searching</li> </ul>	<a href="#"><u>How do I add Reference tags?</u></a>  <a href="#"><u>How do I restrict policy visibility or access?</u></a>
<i>Attachments</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Rename/Replace:</b> Replace updated files as needed</li> <li>Attachments can be any file type desired.</li> </ul>	<a href="#"><u>How do I add a new PDF, image, or other file as an Attachment?</u></a>
<i>Insert Images from your computer</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Add local image as an attachment</li> <li>Place cursor in content where image is desired</li> <li>Click <b>Insert Image</b> button in attachments area</li> </ul>	<a href="#"><u>Can I Insert Images into a Policy?</u></a>
<i>Insert Images from online source</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Copy the URL (web address) for the image</li> <li>Place cursor in content where image is desired</li> <li>Click Image button on toolbar</li> <li>Paste URL in the pop up window and click OK.</li> </ul>	<a href="#"><u>Can I Insert Images into a Policy? - Online Images</u></a>
<i>Copy/Paste Text</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Copy/paste content both within and outside of PolicyStat:</li> <li>Use Ctrl+C / Ctrl+V on your keyboard.</li> <li>Copying external content removes extraneous formatting</li> </ul>	<a href="#"><u>Use The Keyboard (Ctrl + V) to Paste</u></a>

<i>Headings</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Increased font sizes, hyperlinked headings, and numbered headings to improve lists</li> </ul>		<a href="#">Working with Numbered Headings</a>
<i>Find/Replace</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Locate character, word, or phrase</li> <li>Replace with alternative text if needed/desired</li> </ul>		<a href="#">How do I find and replace text in the Editor?</a>
<i>Numbered Lists</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Create and modify numbered lists including style options</li> </ul>		<a href="#">How do I add a Numbered List to my policy?</a>
<i>Bulleted lists</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Create and modify bulleted lists</li> </ul>		<a href="#">What are Bulleted Lists?</a>
<i>Hyperlinking</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Create hyperlinks to external sites, between two policies or to external pages or forms.</li> </ul>		<a href="#">How do I Link to another Policy, Website, or File from within a Policy?</a>
<i>Add Symbol or Special Characters</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Add symbols or special characters to a policy.</li> </ul>		<a href="#">How do I add Symbols or Special Characters to my policy?</a>
<i>Insert and Format Tables</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Insert Table:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Place cursor in paragraph box</li> <li>Click Table button from toolbar</li> </ol> </li> <li>Right click to:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Adjust table properties</li> <li>Insert/delete rows/columns</li> <li>Format cells</li> </ul> </li> </ul>		<a href="#">How do I use tables in PolicyStat?</a>
